The Tobacco-Related Disease Research Program (TRDRP) is accepting applications for **Cornelius Hopper Diversity Award Supplement (CHDAS)** to currently-funded TRDRP principal investigators. This supplement is for the training of promising individuals who are pursuing or who want to pursue careers in research and/or in the field of education and dissemination of tobacco-related disease issues. The trainees must be living in California and include those: (a) from socioeconomic, cultural, ethnic, racial, linguistic, and geographic backgrounds who are and/or have been underrepresented in tobacco research; or (b) pursuing a research interest focusing on cultural, societal, or educational problems as they affect underserved segments of society.

Investigators must have at least one year left on their TRDRP award to ensure the best conditions and results for prospective trainees.

Supplement Amount

\$15,000 per year
